 We have 200+ License Plate Frames and will bring some to the Milwaukee 73rd NSDC. Purchased 1½ inch round logo stickers and iron-on patches.





We have 1000 stickers; 200 Car window stickers and 100 patches.

- Square dancing was declining for years before this program was begun and was, unfortunately, still declining when Covid hit in 2020. Most square dancing was stopped for 2 years and is still trying to recover from a nearly 50% decline. More effort is placed on recruiting now and maybe the new logo and slogan and videos will help with the recruiting. 2013 44,000; 2024 23,000
