This year a new, more upbeat and friendly frog has been introduced on a bright green sticker.



Young dancers know that if they see another dancer with either a frog sticker or a dangle on their badge, that dancer welcomes and enjoys dancing with youth. Want to show your support?

## USDA FOUNDERS MEMORIAL YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP

USDA expects to award one scholarship each year on the basis of merit to a high school senior or college freshman who:

- has a record of volunteer service in square dancing, and
- has outstanding leadership potential and communications skills.

Each nominee must be:

- an active square dancer
- a high school senior or college freshman planning to continue their education.
- sponsored by a USDA affiliate organization
- committed to the promotion and perpetuation of the total square dance movement

Scholarship nomination procedures:

- Complete application
- Letter of nomination from USDA affiliate
- Signed by the affiliate President
- Nominees essay of not more than 500 words on the topic the impact square dancing has had on my life.
- Submit the above three items to the USDA Youth Advisor
- Deadline - February 1
- Recipient will be announced at the USDA Annual meeting held during the National Square Dance Convention.

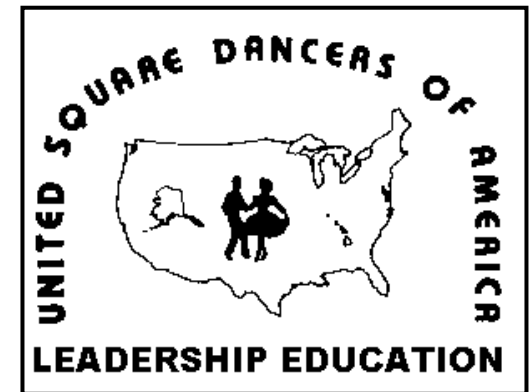
