What are the two most important steps now?

- ▶ 1. Spread the word throughout the dance world to increase awareness of the importance of having new callers, cuers, and dance leaders.
- ▶ 2. Challenge every leader and dancer to help in their own way.

Why are those steps so important?

- * More leaders and dancers need to know how critical this effort is.
- * Every leader and dancer has a role they can act on now.
- * This effort is ongoing and continuous.
- * We are all our best ambassadors.

Why do we call it care and nurturing?

Encouraging and introducing the idea of calling, cueing, or leading should be done:

- tactfully
- at their own pace
- with mini steps
- positive reinforcement
- keep it fun

What is the best way to start?

- ▶ 1. Introduce the idea
- ▶ 2. Start simple with one step
- ▶ 3. Help mentor them to the next step
- ▶ 4. Keep it going and not overwhelming
- ▶ 5. Don't push too hard
- ▶ 6. Keep it fun
